Would you like to offer a student from abroad the opportunity to do an internship in your company or business? This is feasible as long as the [visa](#) and residence requirements are met.

If the intern comes from the EU or [EEA](#), they can be employed without any further restrictions. The same labour law regulations apply for German interns.

Does the student come from a third-country and they travel to Germany in order to complete an internship? Generally, a [residence title](#) is required. With the [residence permit](#) for the purpose of doing an internship, for example, third-country nationals can be employed as interns for up to 6 months without the approval of the [Federal Employment Agency \(BA\)](#).
