Declaration of Commitment

German: Verpflichtungserklärung

People from non-EU States who want to apply for a visa to come to Germany may be invited by people living in Germany if the latter submit a Declaration of Commitment (Verpflichtungserklärung) to a Foreigners Authority in Germany. This declaration obliges the inviter to guarantee the financial support of the visa applicant during their stay in Germany. In some German cities, such as [Offenbach am Main](#) [!\[\]\(003082e50e3009141f59bd5df831749f_img.jpg\)](#) and [Wiesbaden](#) [!\[\]\(f439ede8735757e3190eab35e168f1de_img.jpg\)](#), the declaration can also be submitted via online application.
