You want to work as a professional athlete



When are you considered a professional athlete?

You are considered a professional athlete if you receive more than an expense allowance for your activities.

To obtain a visa to take up employment as an athlete or coach, you must meet the following conditions:

- You must be at least 16 years of age;
- You must work at a German sports club or similar sporting institution. This institution must participate in competitive sport;
- The sports club or institution must pay you an annual gross salary of at least **€50,700** (as of 2026);
- The national governing body of the sport, in agreement with the German Olympic Sports Confederation, has confirmed your eligibility as a professional athlete or your competence as a coach.
